## New Publications on their way

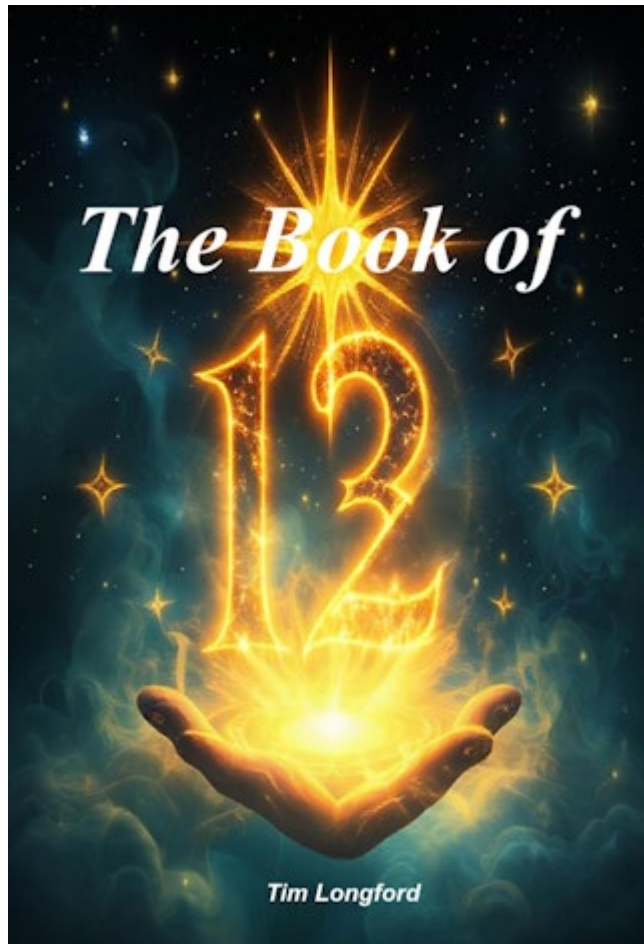

### *The Christmas Yule Log – The Mythology*
